The final recipients, Cody Ruble, who will be attending Purdue University; Kaylee Spivey, who will be attending IUPUI; and August Hunt, who will be attending IUPUI, received a scholarship from the **Willard & Anah Klakamp Fund**.

The Berry, Bauer, and Klakamp scholarships are available to graduating seniors of Seymour High School and provides a four-year renewable scholarship for tuition plus a \$1,000 per year stipend which can be used for any school expense. Tuition paid will be the lesser of actual tuition or the highest annual tuition for any state supported university or college in Indiana.

The Greater Seymour Trust Fund issued scholarships for the 2021/2022 school year in the amount of \$344,444. The Fund has awarded over \$5.58 million to 3,151 students since its inception in 1969.
