Mr. Lanam plans to attend the University of Northwestern Ohio and major in Diesel Engine Repair. Mr. Morris plans to attend Purdue University and major in Computer Engineering. Ms. Turner and Mr. Thomas both plan to attend Indiana University and will major in Zoology (Turner) and Business (Thomas). The Spray fund provides reoccurring yearly scholarships to first-in-their-generation graduating seniors of Seymour High School. A senior must also be a current resident of Jackson County and be the first person in their family whose biological parents, siblings, or grandparents did not complete a four-year college degree.



Luke Lanam, who will be attending the University of Northwestern Ohio, received a scholarship from the **Jim Brock Technology Scholarship Fund**. Mr. Lanam will be majoring in Diesel Engine Repair. The Brock fund provides scholarships to Seymour High School seeking diplomas or certifications in Automotive Technology, Industrial Technology, or Education with an emphasis on Industrial Technology. Preference is given to students majoring in Automotive Technology.

Kendrick Sterling, who will be attending Ohio Dominican University, received a scholarship from the **Blair Trask Memorial Broadcasting Scholarship**. Ms. Sterling plans to major in Sports Management and wants to pursue a career as a Sports Broadcaster or Sports Analyst. The Trask fund provides scholarships to students seeking diplomas or certifications in Radio Broadcasting, Broadcasting Communications, Broadcast Engineering or Radio Production.
